

## PRECEPTORSHIPS &amp; ADVANCED CLINICAL TRAINING PROGRAMS



The UCLA School of Dentistry offers Advanced Clinical Training Programs (ACT) and Preceptorships designed to provide graduates of foreign and U.S. dental schools with postgraduate training in general dentistry and a wide range of specialty fields. Programs vary in length from one quarter to three years culminating in the issuance of a certificate of completion.

## APPLICATION PROCESS

- Preceptor & ACT Application Form (download from website)
- Official dental transcripts translated into English or ECE course-by-course evaluated report
- (3) Confidential Recommendation Reports (download from website)
- TOEFL or IELTS score for applicants whose first language is not English
- Application fee of \$150.00 by check or money order from a U.S. bank made out to “U.C. Regents”
